- •Killarney Recreation Club, Willow St, Killarney on **Saturday 22 July 2017 by 1pm**.

- •See Drum Steward on arrival and get your location.
- •Build up a bed of sand 5cm deep with a 10cm margin around drum.

Attend and supervise your drum

- •Killarney Bonfire Night is on Saturday 22 July, 2017
- •Judging is from 4pm.
- •The Rural Fire Brigade light drums after they are judged at 4.30pm.
- •Unsafe drums will not be lit.
- •Drum Hosts oversee the crowd in drum areas during the event. Please follow their directions.
- •You remain responsible for the safety of your drum during the event.
- •Please advise a Drum Host if you are leaving before 9pm.

Pick up your drum

- •Remove drums Sunday 23rd July.
- •Clean up any rubbish, coals, or embers around your drum area.
- Any remaining embers in drum to be disposed of safely into main bonfire area.
- •Children to be in the immediate supervision of an adult at all times during pick-up
